1 About the restoration disks

The “NVR Standard HAW-S 2017-R2 System-backup-image restoration disks” provide image files of bootable USB disks for restoring your system backup to HAW-SIBU server.

2 Applicable model/edition/version/revision

The “NVR Standard HAW-S 2017-R2 System-backup-image restoration disks” are applicable for:

- Network Video Recorder Standard edition HAW-SIBU Version 2017-R2 Rev.A
- Network Video Recorder Standard edition HAW-SIBU Version 2017-R2 Rev.B
- Network Video Recorder Standard edition HAW-SIBU Version 2017-R2 Rev.C

Note that the restoration disks can not be used for model(s)/version(s)/revision(s) other than the above ones.

3 How to choose a suitable restoration disk out of the three

There are 3 restoration disks for HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 series, and you are required to strictly choose a suitable restoration disk out of the 3 depending on condition of your HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 server.

To know which restore disk is a suitable one in your case, check condition of your HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 with the steps below before starting restoration.

- 1) Start your HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 server.
- 2) Log on to Windows as administrator.
- 3) Press [Windows] key, then type `clitest`, and finally press [Enter] key.
- 4) Popped-up window requires user authentication. Enter administration user name of the RAID Configuration Tool and press [Enter] key. Enter password for the user and press [Enter] key. (Note: Refer to the technical document “NVR Standard HAW-S Maintenance guide” for default user name and password of RAID Configuration Tool administrator)
- 5) Type `ctrl_ -v` (where `_` is a white space) and press [Enter] key.
- 6) Find a line containing string “InstallPkgVersion:”. (Note: Scrolling up will be required to see the line)
- 7) With the following criteria, check a suitable restore disk corresponding to a condition of your HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 server.

Case-A) Restoration disk only for HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 Rev.A

When the line is “InstallPkgVersion: 0.02.2060.09”,
you are required to choose the restoration disk image file

“NVR_Standard_HAW-SIBU_2017-R2_Rev-A_System-backup-image_Restoration-disk.img”.

Case-B) Restoration disk only for HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 Rev.B

When the line is “InstallPkgVersion: 0.02.2060.11”,
you are required to choose the restoration disk image file
“NVR_Standard_HAW-SIBU_2017-R2_Rev-B_System-backup-image_Restoration-disk.img”.

Case-C) Restoration disk only for HAW-SIBU 2017-R2 Rev.C

When the line is “InstallPkgVersion: 0.02.2060.14”,
you are required to choose the restoration disk image file
“NVR_Standard_HAW-SIBU_2017-R2_Rev-C_System-backup-image_Restoration-disk.img”.
